ONLY COMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL BE CONSIDERED.

Deadline for receipt of application is April 21, 2017 at 4:30 pm.

Submission of documents does not guarantee acceptance.

Overall scores based on the Rio Hondo ISD criteria will determine eligibility for consideration. Alternates will be placed on a wait list for attrition purposes based on ranking order.

The applicant will receive *an official letter* stating the applicant's status:

- **Not Recommended** – student has not been recommended to the RHISD STEM/STAMP program.
- **Recommended Alternate** – student is placed on a wait list for attrition purposes based on ranking order in the event that a **Recommended** student declines their “offer” of Acceptance
- **Recommended** – student is formally recommended to RHISD and must respond to the “offer” of Acceptance within the designated time.
